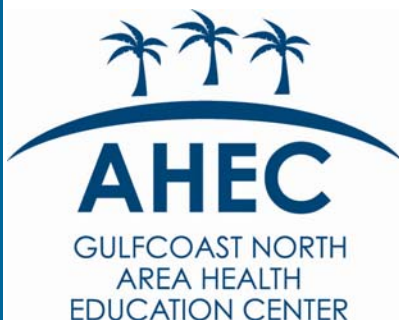

## HEALTHCARE ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
